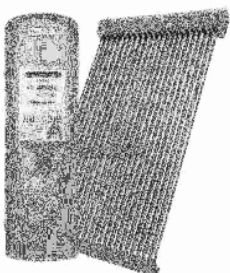

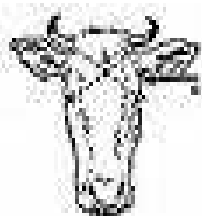

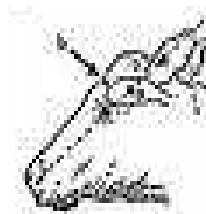

**MACARTHUR CHILDCARE CENTRE** has just received confirmation that their grant application to the Macarthur Wind Farm Community Fund for funding of \$7,791.00 has been **successful**. The childcare centre has been working very hard trying to obtain funding for a shade sail, rubber soft fall and equipment for the children who use the centre.

In February the centre was successful, with the help of Cathy Harbison and MADA, in obtaining \$7,380 for shade from the Macpherson Smith Community Alliance Fund. This was combined with the generous donations of \$500 from the Macarthur Lions Club, \$250 from Macarthur CFA and \$500 from MADA to cover the cost. Our funding is now complete for this project and we will be purchasing the equipment and erecting shade and laying the rubber soft fall very soon - weather permitting - this is what we have been striving for.

Previously the childcare centre did not have a shaded area for the children to play outside during the hot summers we have been having. With this funding, donations and the shade that Corangamite Shire has erected over the sand pit, the regions children attending the Macarthur Childcare Centre will have a safe environment and families can rest assure that their children are in the best possible care.
