

The preschool has had a good start to the year's fundraising with a cake stall at the community auction on



the 21<sup>st</sup> March. We raised \$240 from the day and also made \$114 last term from the collection of aluminium cans. Anyone with aluminium cans to donate to the preschool can drop these into the red bin at the preschool.

Our four year old preschool class continues to settle in well with lots of artistic paintings and drawings being produced. The class is currently looking at the change of season from summer to autumn, investigating things such as autumn leaves and mush-

rooms.

The major fundraiser for the year is being planned, to be a "Trade Stall evening and Mystery Bottle Auction". This will be publicised over the next four weeks, and will be held in the evening on the 18<sup>th</sup> June at the Macarthur Recreation Centre. Please put this date in your diary and come along for a great night out!

The preschool has been successful in applying for a refurbishment and development grant with the government, resulting in us receiving \$20,000. This will be used to purchase a number of items including a shade sail to go over the outdoor climbing area, a washer/dryer combo machine, a hot water urn, brochure stand and shelving for the office and outside shed. This will allow us to better utilise the facilities we already have and is a major bonus for the centre.

Finally, we are calling for all parents who wish for their child to start the three year old kinder class in the third term, to return their completed enrolment form back to the preschool as soon as possible. We are soon to be advertising the teaching position for this class, and need to confirm student numbers quickly.
